
MORE NEWS FROM RUTH SMITH

A message from Rev Peter

Lent gives Christians a consecrated time for God to do a new work of grace in our lives. Lent takes us from the penitence of Ash Wednesday on 5th March to the joyful dawn of Easter Day on 20th April. Lent invites us to walk with Christ along the way of the cross.

It is the way of self-denial. It is the narrow way of love. In Jesus we see a man in whose life, death and resurrection God demonstrates His unending love for us all. The season of Lent can become for us a journey of discovery of God's love. We can make new discoveries about ourselves. It is a season to think about and be challenged by what we consume, lest our material possessions or cravings consume us. Some will decide to give something up and others will decide to take something up – a new challenge or interest perhaps.

Lent is a time to reflect upon our spiritual growth and development. It is my hope and prayer that you will find the time and space to map out a way through Lent. May we discover the strength of God to walk with Christ, sharing in his sorrows and in his victory. May we discover his comforting presence and solidarity in our own sufferings and in the suffering of others. Lent gives Christians a consecrated time for God to do a new work of grace in our lives.
